



Micropigmentation and Aesthetics

Sensitivity Test

- 1) In the provided envelope you will find 2 plasters:
 - One impregnated with permanent cosmetic pigment.
 - One impregnated with anaesthetic.
- 2) Fold back the protective backing on one of the plasters to reveal the pigment.
- 3) Re- hydrate the pigment by adding a drop of tap water to the plaster.
- 4) Place the plaster on the top of your left thigh.
- 5) Repeat this procedure for the second plaster that is impregnated with anaesthetic. In this case placing the plaster on your right thigh.
- 6) After 24 hours remove the plaster and examine the skin. If there is no reaction, i.e. redness, swelling, irritation or itching it is safe to proceed with your enhancement.
- 7) Should you experience any of the symptoms mentioned above, remove the plaster and immediately flush the area with cold water.
- 8) Please telephone Faye Marie on 07799145022 to report the test results.
- 9) Please note that the correct colour will be mixed for you at your scheduled appointment. The colour is for sensitivity test purposes only.
- 10) On completion of your sensitivity test sign below and bring the completed document to your appointment.
